

SUMMARY OF APRIL 28, 2022 COUNCIL MEETING

Hull City Council met in person at the Jackson EMC Community Meeting Room for their regular meeting. Mayor Pro Tem Donna Sherrer-Gantt presided in the absence of the Mayor. All council members were present. Due to a scheduling conflict the Clerk was present via telephone. Due to a prior commitment was unable to attend the meeting.

The minutes and financial reports were approved with a correction on the ARPA statement.

Under old business, Mayor Prom Tem Gantt advised that there had been no response to the ad placed in the Madison County Journal nor from any council member with respect to suggestions for the design for the mural to be placed on the side of the Chevron. In that regard Mayor Walton has met with the artist, Mr. Flanigan, and discussed the mural in detail. Work should begin on or about May 1st.

Mayor Pro Tem also advised that the City should be receiving additional ARPA funds in May once Mayor Walton has completed the report with respect to the funds already received.

Mayor Pro Tem advised that April was Clerk Appreciation Month and in that regard a recommendation was made that the Clerk be given \$60.00 in keeping with past years to show appreciation to her. Motion was made seconded and approved to do this.

Mayor Pro Tem advised that Mayor Walton had requested that he be given an advance on his salary due to unforeseen circumstances. He is requesting to receive his salary for January through April in the amount of \$833.36. Motion made, seconded and approved.

The Clerk advised that approval was needed by Mayor and Council for the IGA between the Board of Elections, Board of Commissioners and the City so that the county could conduct elections for the City. The Agreement is basically the same that had been in place previously. Motion was made, seconded and approved to accept this IGA.

Council member Koepnick gave an update on the landscaping and also addressed some concerns about watering and the need for new mulch or pine straw. He will obtain some estimates and the matter was tabled until May for further discussion

There was no further business and the meeting was adjourned.
