

Summary of August 28, 2025 Council Meeting

Mayor and Council met for its regular meeting on Thursday, August 28, 2025, at Hull City Hall. The Mayor and all council members were present with the exception of council member, Paige Phillips, who was on vacation and excused., in addition to the Clerk and City Attorney. Also in attendance was Mr. Lynn Shedd.

The minutes and financial reports were approved as presented.

The Clerk reported that both council members Mike McElroy and Steven Hollingsworth had qualified for re-election and no one else had qualified so there would not be an election and both council members will be sworn in for their new term at the December, 2025 meeting.

There was discussion about having the current lawn maintenance contract extended so that the company could work on cleaning up the curbs and medians, trimming the crepe myrtles, etc. Mayor Barber is to get back with Green Scenez to discuss further and the matter was tabled until the September meeting.

Mayor Barber presented a quote from Allegiance Flag Company to repair the current flag pole, add the new flags and a light for \$566.40. This was approved.

A first reading of a ordinance governing Buildings and Building Regulations Construction Code was read and approved by counsel. A second reading and vote to be taken at the September council meeting.

The council voted to hire Lynn Shedd as it Building Inspection Officer.

The council approved a plat to subdivide approximately 3 acres on Glenn Carrie Road into two 1.5 acre tracts to allow for the construction of two single family dwellings.
